Fourth Commandment: Honor your father and your mother.

How can we live out the Fourth Commandment?

We live out the Fourth Commandment when we **honor and obey** our parents, our guardians, and all those who lead and serve us.

<u>Domestic Church</u> The Church in the home, which every Christian family is called to be

We are called to **respect** those who have a responsibility for us.

People in authority are called to **respect the dignity** of all people.

Christian families are called to be communities of faith, hope, and love.

Holy Family Jesus, Mary, and Joseph are called this.

Obedience doing the just and good things that are asked of us.



Fifth Commandment: You shall not kill.

What is the Fifth Commandment based on?

The Fifth Commandment is based on the belief that <u>all human life is sacred</u>, created by God.

How can we live out the Fifth Commandment?

We live out the Fifth Commandment when we **respect and protect** each human life.

Human Dignity the value and worth each person has from being created in God's image.

The most basic human right is the **right to life**.

All human life should be cared for and protected because it is **sacred**.

Peace comes about when people truly love one another and work for justice.

The Church works for peace by making sure people have the things **they need to live**.

When we take care of ourselves and help others, we show our respect for the gift of life.

Sixth Commandment: You shall not commit adultery.

How do we live out the Sixth Commandment?

We live out the Sixth Commandment when we honor marriage vows, respect our own bodies, and express our feelings in a proper way.

Adultery is being unfaithful to one's spouse.

Virtue a good habit that helps us to act according to God's love for us.

Chastity the virtue by which we use our human sexuality in a responsible and faithful way.

In the Sacrament of **Matrimony**, the bride and groom make a vow to be faithful to each other.

<u>Friendship</u> is one way we grow in love.
