

## Religion Study Guide: Commandments 4-6

### **Fourth Commandment: Honor your father and your mother.**

#### **How can we live out the Fourth Commandment?**

We live out the Fourth Commandment when we **honor and obey** our parents, our guardians, and all those who lead and serve us.

**Domestic Church** The Church in the home, which every Christian family is called to be

We are called to **respect** those who have a responsibility for us.

People in authority are called to **respect the dignity** of all people.

Christian families are called to be communities of **faith, hope, and love**.

**Holy Family** Jesus, Mary, and Joseph are called this.

**Obedience** doing the just and good things that are asked of us.



### **Fifth Commandment: You shall not kill.**

#### **What is the Fifth Commandment based on?**

The Fifth Commandment is based on the belief that **all human life is sacred**, created by God.

#### **How can we live out the Fifth Commandment?**

We live out the Fifth Commandment when we **respect and protect** each human life.

**Human Dignity** the value and worth each person has from being created in God's image.

The most basic human right is the **right to life**.

All human life should be cared for and protected because it is **sacred**.

**Peace** comes about when people truly love one another and work for justice.

The Church works for peace by making sure people have the things **they need to live**.

When we **take care of ourselves and help others**, we show our respect for the gift of life.

## **Sixth Commandment: You shall not commit adultery.**

### **How do we live out the Sixth Commandment?**

We live out the Sixth Commandment when we honor marriage vows, respect our own bodies, and express our feelings in a proper way.

**Adultery** is being unfaithful to one's spouse.

**Virtue** a good habit that helps us to act according to God's love for us.

**Chastity** the virtue by which we use our human sexuality in a responsible and faithful way.

In the Sacrament of **Matrimony**, the bride and groom make a vow to be faithful to each other.

**Friendship** is one way we grow in love.
